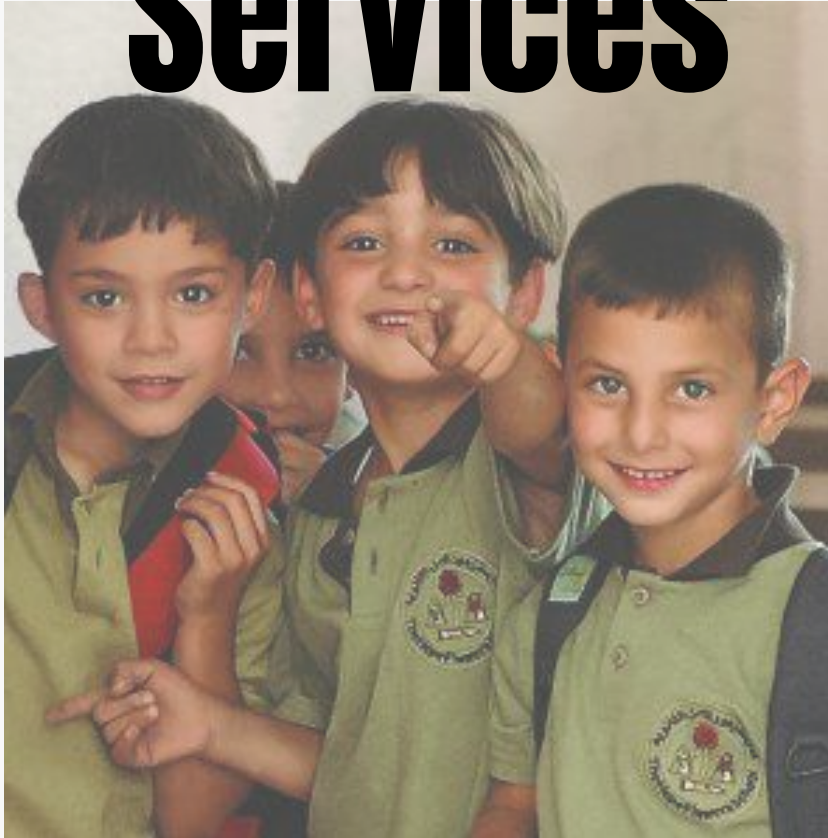

01 Fiscal Sponsorship

Fiscal sponsors are tax-exempt, charitable ventures that, according to a recent IRS report "have the ability to receive charitable contributions for specific projects, the infrastructure to ensure compliance with applicable federal and state laws and adequate internal controls to ensure that the funds will be used for the intended charitable purposes." Simply stated, fiscal sponsors place responsibility for implementing programs in the hands of project leaders while ensuring appropriate fiduciary oversight.

Humanitarian Social Innovations was founded as a fiscal sponsor and continues as the premier fiscal sponsor in our region.

02 Contracted Services

Following the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, Humanitarian Social Innovations began offering the strength of its infrastructure at below market value to existing stand-alone nonprofit organizations in order to bolster them through that difficult season. These services continue to be offered to the sector.

03 Capacity Building

Humanitarian Social Innovations continues to be a thought leader and innovator in the region through the development of the Nonprofit Business Excellence Lab. (NONBEL) NONBEL is a proprietary stepwise capacity building system for HSI programs and existing nonprofits.

Humanitarian Social Innovations is a fiscal sponsor composed of programs that demonstrate a benefit to humanity.

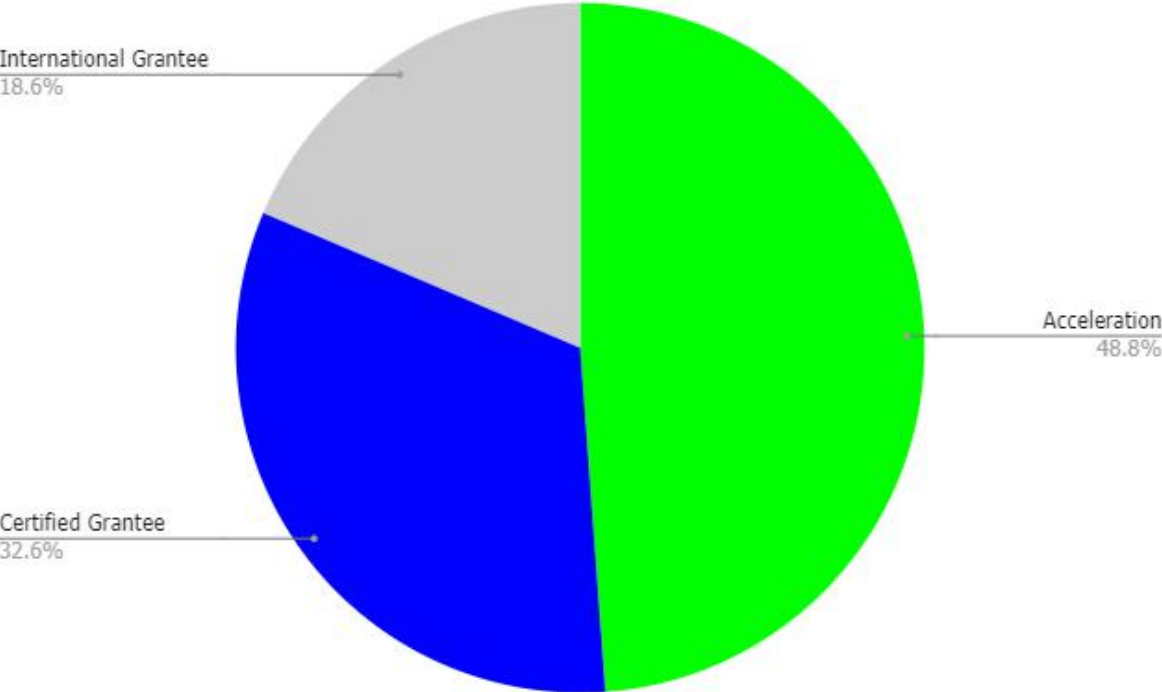

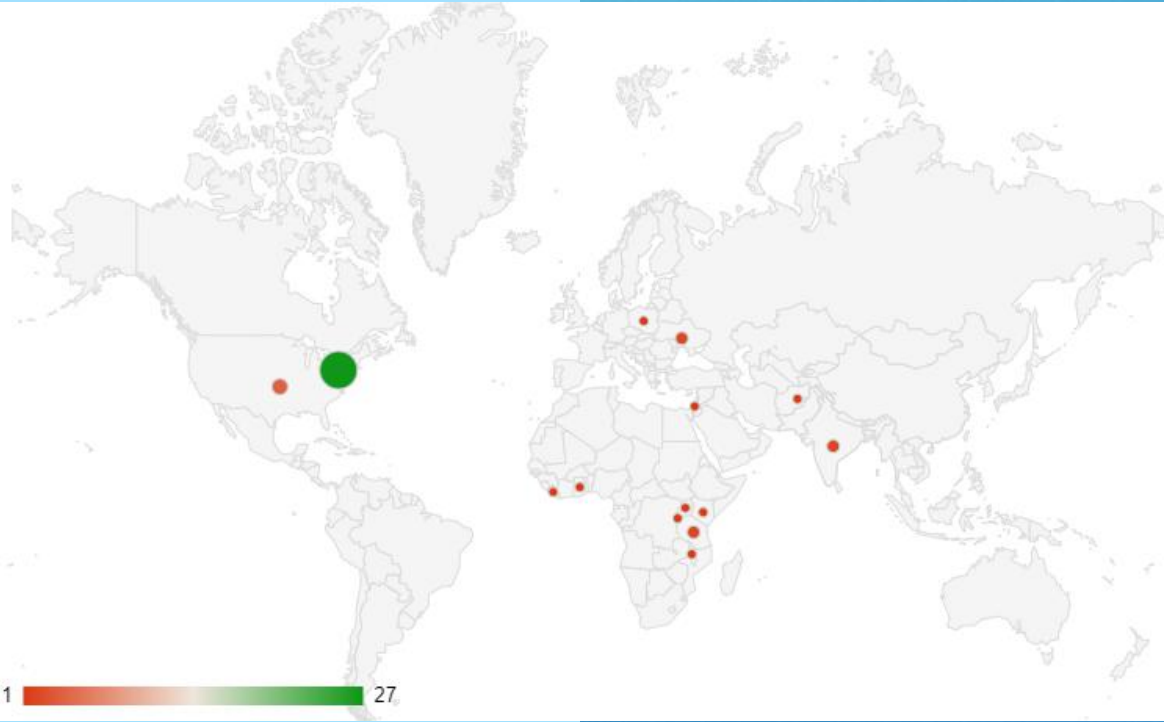

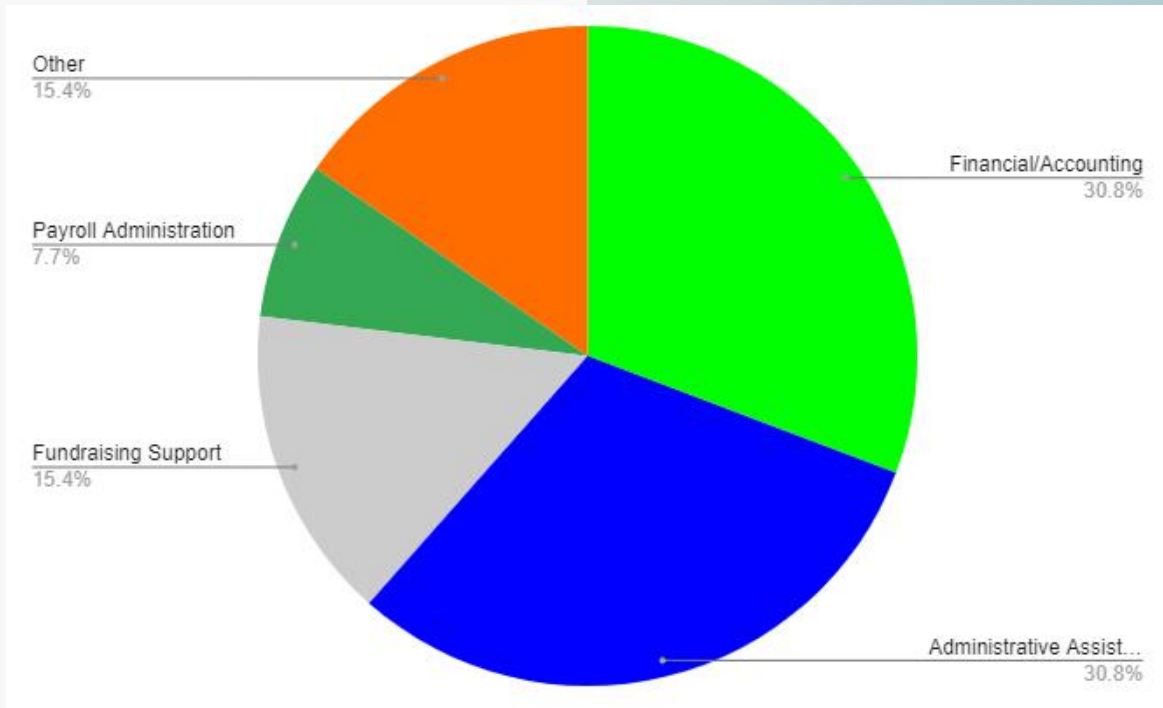

Program Spotlight



Women who flee a domestic violence situation usually do so with only what they can easily and inconspicuously carry with them. Blessed Beginnings provides these women with a starter basket of household supplies to help them

get started in their first home upon leaving the shelter. If children are involved, they also provide items such as toys or books so that each child can start with something of his or her own.

Since its launch in 2021, Blessed Beginnings had provided 70 baskets to 6 partner organizations: Safe Berks and Hannah's Hope in Reading, Schuylkill Hope Center in Pottsville, Beyond the Violence in Berwick, Aspire to Autonomy in Bethlehem, and Turning Point of Lehigh Valley in Allentown.

Blessed Beginnings joined the HSI program community in June of 2021. HSI manages the details of running a nonprofit organization, allowing Jordan and her team to focus on helping women start over.



Yaro Hnatusko is a Ukrainian student at East Tennessee State University. His brother, Stan, is the CEO of Atlant, the largest supplier of building supplies in Ukraine, headquartered in Kharkiv.

When Russia invaded Ukraine, Stan set aside his company's commercial

concerns and converted Atlant's HQ and warehouses into shelters, kitchens, and food banks for the displaced citizens of Kharkiv, now known as the most bombed city of the war. Knowing the relief work would need structure, Stan initiated an NGO in Kharkiv, Restore Ukraine.

Yaro works hard as a US liaison to raise funds, build relationships, and share the work of Restore Ukraine. To date, over \$1.5 M in relief funds have provided daily food for 3500+ people of Kharkiv. That is 300 tons of food along with 4500 hygiene kits and 800 tons of building materials used to rebuild 40 apartments damaged by missiles.

While Stan was busy with relief efforts on the ground in Kharkiv, Yaro set up an international fiscal sponsorship for Restore Ukraine through HSI allowing HSI to directly sponsor the relief work in Kharkiv.

Program Spotlight



Safe Communities works to protect children from sexual abuse through empowering them and educating adults; and create safe spaces for survivors to heal, seek justice and build peer connections.

This program was able to impact the lives of over 1,850 adults, youth, children and survivors in 2022, compared to 1,304 in 2021.

They accomplish this through public workshops offered on Zoom and Vimeo on many topics from prevention of childhood sexual abuse to mandated reporter training. They also act as advocates at the state and local level to improve response to victims and are particularly effective in plain communities where the culture has largely silenced victims in the past. They work with churches, regional church bodies, and community organizations to embed practices that prioritize prevention. There is so



much more. They also have created Circle of Hope, a group for survivors of childhood sexual abuse who are living with this trauma every day.

More exciting news is that in June, Safe Communities launched their RACHEL PROJECT, which included writing a 60-page workbook for use in their newly-formed Rachels' Sisters healing groups for Amish women. "The faith-integrated workbook educates women on the impact of trauma while fostering their healing through a dynamic process of study, discussion, therapeutic processing, self-awareness exercises, and tools for self-regulation."

Safe Communities started as an idea within a local NPO. As it outgrew that NPO, they launched out into the safety net of a fiscal sponsor, HSI. Under our umbrella they established operational and programmatic processes with the goal of becoming a stand-alone 501(c)(3).



Youth Empowerment For Advancement Hangout (YEAH) is a black-led, community-based nonprofit that works with teens and

young adults in west and southwest Philadelphia ages 15 to 24 who have been impacted by violence. With a special focus on those labeled as having violent histories, YEAH acknowledges teens and young adults as the experts of their own lives and prioritizes pushing back against oppressive systems and addressing structural barriers that often lead to violence.

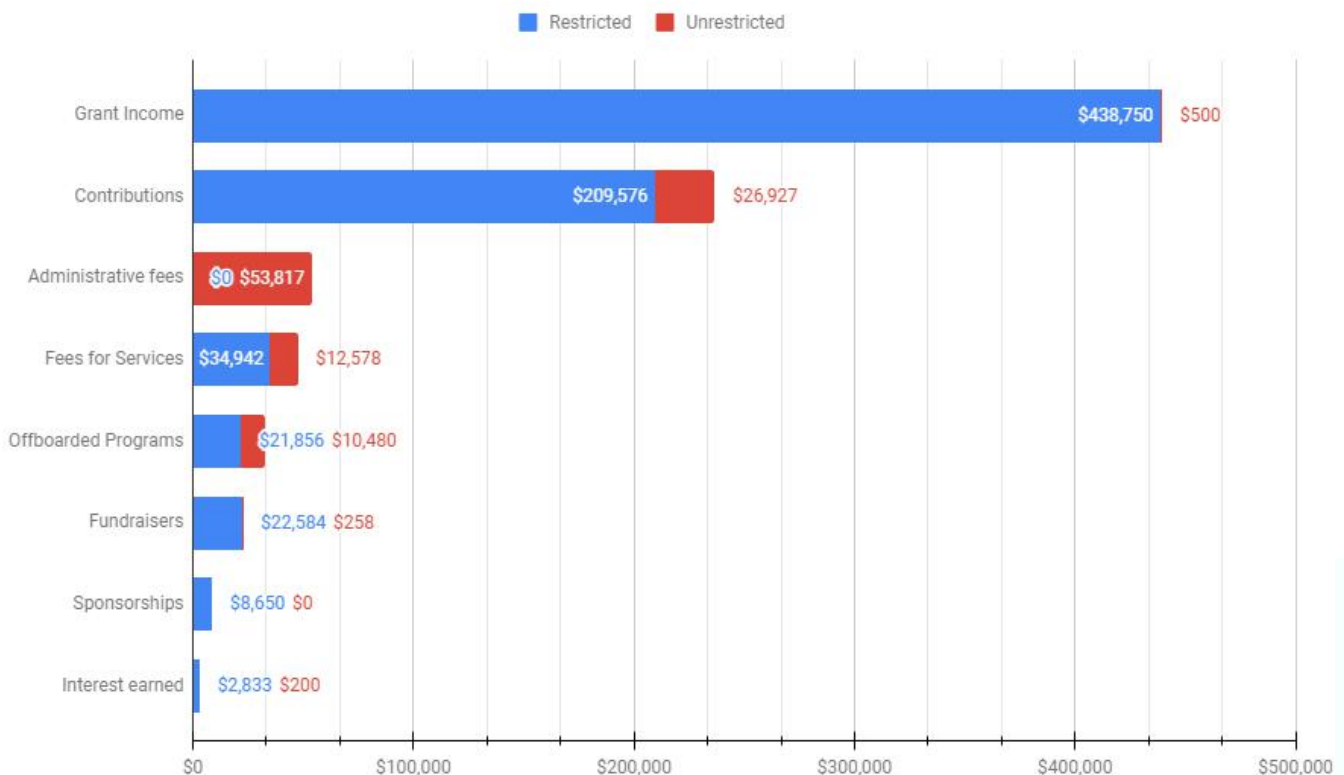

One program's restricted funds are never used for unrestricted purposes or for the support of a different program.

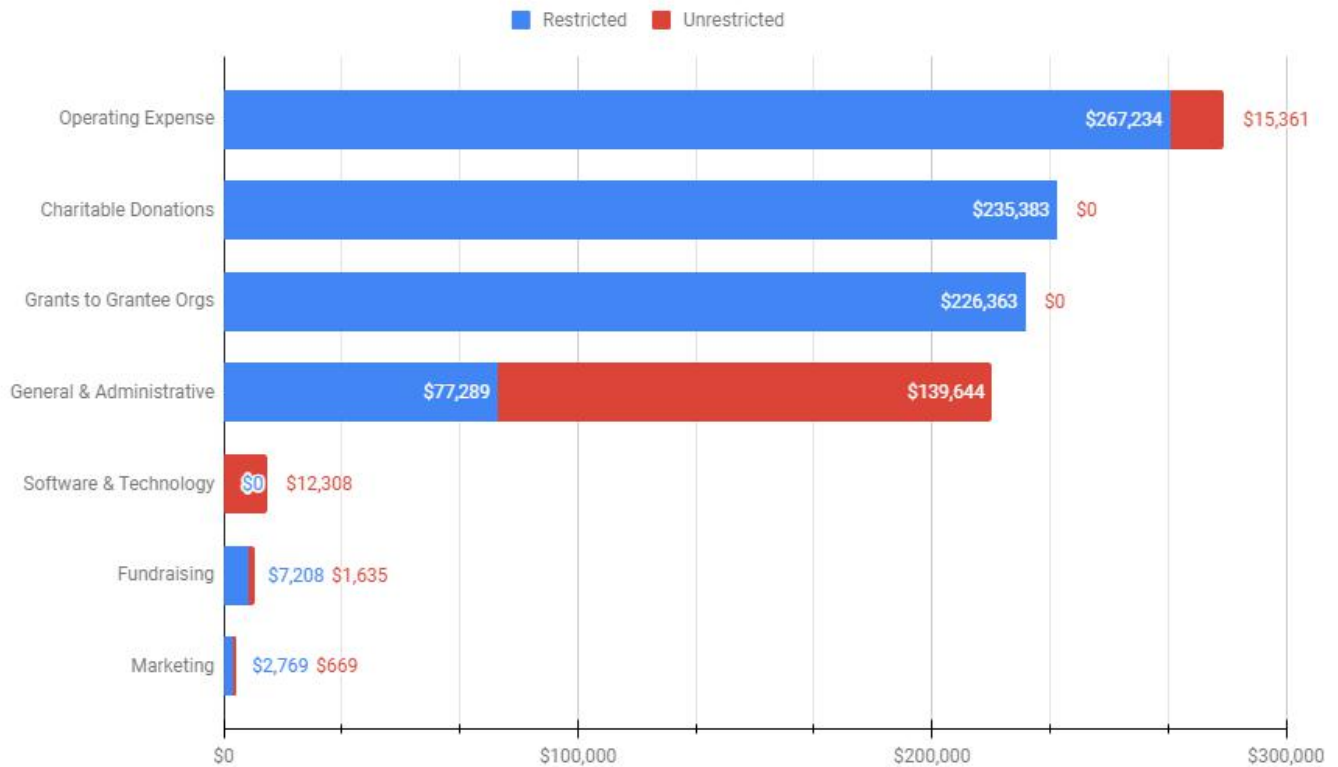

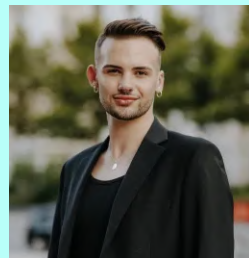
